Introducing Learning for Discipleship

What is Learning for Discipleship?

Learning for Discipleship is a new initiative in response to popular demand. It has been running successfully for two years now, with a large number of learners enjoying and benefitting from it. It's an easy and accessible way for Christians to learn more about their faith and grow in discipleship.

It's made up of a number of courses, each normally consisting of ten 2 hour evening sessions or equivalent, which may include some Saturdays or a combination of both.

There are no entry requirements or previous experience necessary — everybody is welcome.

You can enrol for a single course or go on to do as many more as you like.



Where do I go to study?

Courses will run on a rolling basis at a number of learning centres around the Diocese.

You can start a course whenever there is one running at a centre you want to go to.

If you have plenty of time for study you could do more than one course at the same time on different evenings.

If life is busy you could do a single course then take a break and come back when you're ready.

This is learning that is flexible to your needs and your lifestyle.

The learning materials for courses are available on a special website (called Moodle) which students are strongly encouraged to use.

What will it cost?

Each course costs £35 per student.

Do I get a qualification?

You are welcome to attend Learning for Discipleship courses just for enjoyment. The five core courses could earn you the Bishop's Award in Christian Discipleship (see separate leaflet for details).

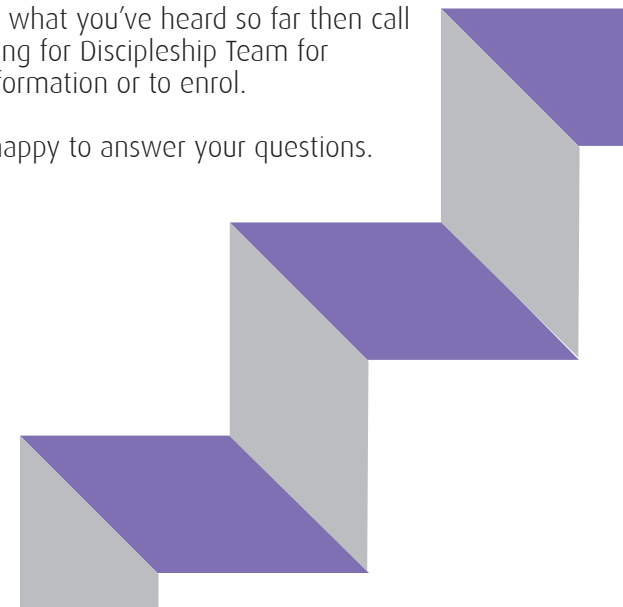
For those who wish to explore theological studies in greater depth, it is possible to register for the Foundation Degree. You will then take exactly the same courses but will be asked to write essays and construct a portfolio for each course. You will be given clear guidance on how to do this. You may leave the course with either a University Certificate (8 modules) or a Foundation Degree (university diploma - another 8 modules). This can be converted later into an Honours degree if you wish. You may also be eligible for accreditation for any prior work you have done.
